To whom it may concern:

Thyroid tablets marketed by ECI2012 are manufactured according to current Good Manufacturing Practices standards and are compliant with the Canadian standard for Thyroid C.06.250 in Food and Drug Regulations CRC c.870.

The Thyroid conversion table lists the approximate equivalents of other thyroid preparations, when changing medication from desiccated thyroid, T4 (levothyroxine sodium), or T3 (liothyronine sodium).

Levels of liothyronine (T3) and levothyroxine (T4) are not tested when of the release of Thyroid tablets and therefore are not available. Nevertheless, the desiccated Thyroid active ingredient used for the production of Thyroid tablets is compliant with T3 and T4 levels according to US Pharmacopeia.
